- 9:30-10:30 AM - Information meeting with parents of Jamboree Scouts, pick up Council-supplied Jamboree gear for your Scout (*dining hall*)
- 12:00 Noon - Pick up lunch from commissary and prepare at campsite
- 1:30 - 4:30 PM
 - Patrol and troop activities (patrol flags, gateway painting, etc.) about 2 hours in afternoon (*SM's and ASM's to coordinate*)
 - Various afternoon activities
- 5:00 PM - Pick up dinner from commissary and prepare at campsite
- 5:30 PM - Supper prep, supper, clean-up (*per patrol duty rosters*)
- 7:00 PM - Evening campfire (*Council ring*)
- 9:00 PM - Cracker barrel - (*Main Dining Hall*)
- 9:30 PM - Scoutmaster/SPL meeting (*McKinstry Lounge*)
- 10:30 PM - Taps

- 6:30 AM - Reveille
- 6:45 AM - Food Pick-up, breakfast prep, breakfast, cleanup (*per patrol duty rosters*)
- 8:30 AM - Troop PLC meetings
- 9:00 AM - Scout's Own Worship (*Troop Chaplains Aides*)
- 10:00 AM - Campsite teardown, troops to record equipment damages requiring repair, return equipment and equipment reports
- 11:30 AM - Departure, remaining Jamboree gear is issued to Scouts on the way out
