District Training Award

The Winnebago Council Training Committee is pleased to offer an award that can be earned by all Winnebago Council *adult leaders involved in the Cub Scout, Boy Scout and Venturing programs*. This award is unique to the Winnebago Council and is called the **District Training Award**. Upon earning this award you will receive a cloth knot that is also unique to this Council that can be worn above your left pocket. The knot contains a blue rope, representing Cub Scouting joined in a square knot with a red rope, representing Boy Scouting. The knot is embroidered to a khaki cloth background that contains a green embroidered border, which represents Venturing. You may earn this award for each of the three Scouting venues as long as you meet the requirements for each venue. To display receipt of this award for more than one venue, “device pins” can be attached to the “Training Award Knot” representing the venue for which it was earned.

~~ Application Procedure ~~

1. District Training Award Applications can be obtained at District Roundtables, Training Events and the Scout Service Centers.
2. The prospective District Training Award recipient completes the specified requirements.
3. The prospective District Training Award recipient obtains the signatures for verification of the following:
 - District Roundtable attendance.
 - Completion of the required training events for their respective Scouting venue.
4. The prospective District Training Award recipient submits the completed application to their respective District Training Chair containing one of the following signatures on the top-line of the “District Committee Action” section of the application: District Committee Chair **or** District Commissioner **or** District Executive.
5. District Training Chair signs the completed application and then submits it to the Council Service Center-Waterloo Office to the attention of the Winnebago Council Training Chair.
6. Council Training Chair produces the District Training Knot Certificate, which will contain the recipient’s name. The Council Training Chair and the Council Executive sign the “certificate” which then gets forwarded along with the District Training Award “Knot” to the respective District Executive from the recipient’s district.
7. District Executive or District Training Chair presents the certificate to the District Training Award recipient at an appropriate time (roundtable, etc).

Note: The District Training Award can be earned at anytime for any of the three Scouting venues. However, all requirements for the District Training Award must be completed within a **two-year** time period beginning from the first date that is recorded for completing of one of the three training events that is required for each venue. Although not a stipulation for earning this award, it is recommended that the training events be completed in the following order: Fast Start, New Leader Essentials and Position Specific Training. Fast Start and New Leader Essentials only need to be taken one time regardless of how many times the District Training Award is earned.
