Horse rides must be scheduled a minimum of 5-days in advance. Trail rides occur during daylight hours, weather and ground conditions permitting(Weather must be above freezing, no ice, no deep snow or raining wet trails, etc.). Trail Riders on our horses must be at least **11 years of age or older. Each horse accommodates one rider only. If younger than age 11, please book an arena ride: you are asked to have people to help with leading the horses used for youth under age 11 on Arena Rides. We provide two Wranglers.**

A paid minimum of 6 is needed to reserve a ride. If you pay for six and only two go out on the ride, it is your choice: you will pay the minimum. A maximum of 10 riders or as directed by Trail Boss: Larger groups may be split into two groups for a "back-to-back-ride". Each ride includes instruction time before heading out on the trail for 45-60 minutes. Allow extra time for this in your planning.

1. Reservations are accepted on a first come, first served, and paid in full basis.
2. If your unit, group, family or organization cancels a reservation, the fees are not refundable but are transferable to another scheduled ride. If cancelled seven days or less prior to the date of your ride, a 50% penalty will be assessed. Groups more than 15 minutes late: the ride may be cancelled /no refund.
3. At least two adults must accompany all youth groups and be in attendance at all times during their stay. One adult must be at least 21 years of age and one must be at least 18 years of age.
4. Health and accident insurance is a unit, organization, individual and parental responsibility. It is NOT provided by the Wapsie Wranglers as part of the trail ride fee.
5. **ALL RIDERS**, (including adults), **must bring a signed horse authorization & consent form** in order to ride. Children under the age of 18 may not ride without a signature of his/her parent or guardian. The forms will be collected once the group arrives at the *Camp Ingawanis Stable*.
6. **ALL RIDERS** are required to **wear long pants & hard-soled shoes**. Tennis shoes with a full heel will also work. Shoes NOT permitted: Sandals, clogs, "open-toed" or "open heeled" shoes. This attire protects riders from saddle sores, foot injuries & getting cut-up on the trails, etc.
7. We provide the required **riding helmets for all riders under 21**. You may wear your own ATSM-SEI approved helmet.
8. **Horsemanship** for scouting badge, is available. Book in advance for staffing & scheduling purposes.
9. If a rider that has **physical limitations or other special needs, please** notify us during your reservation. We apologize that we do not have horses able to accommodate riders over **240 pounds**. The Wranglers on site will make all horse assignments, based on the rider's size **and ability**. Riders must be able to mount and dismount the horse under their own power without use of assistive devices. The Wranglers are in charge at all times. Decisions of the Wranglers are final. This is for the safety of all.
10. The adults accompanying youth groups are to maintain control of the group and administer discipline.

11. Camp Ingawanis is a drug free facility: NO Alcohol /or Drugs.
